

The Devil's DNA - John 8:37-47 From the Series, Believe:879 *By Pastor Skip Heitzig*

MESSAGE SUMMARY

Your body has 100 trillion cells. Inside each one is a nucleus and in each nucleus are DNA molecules. DNA is like an instruction manual for life with densely coded information telling each cell what to do. A simple paternity test would prove that my father was really my father. Here Jesus gives His audience a spiritual paternity test that reveals their spiritual father to be the devil himself. No matter what your physical ancestry, you can always tell one's spiritual heritage.



DETAILED NOTES

Universalism is the belief that everyone, no matter who they are or what they believe will eventually be saved; the universal Fatherhood of God and brotherhood of man. It is a lovely thought; however, it is wrong. If you believe the Bible, or even just the words of Christ, you could not come to that conclusion. It is a worldview that is different from reality. God is not the Father of all humanity. He is not the Father of many who think he is their Father.

This group Jesus is addressing in this text believed God was their Father, but they had murder in their heart, detested truth, and hated God's messenger.

- I. The Premise (vv. 37-47)
 - A. The Devil is Real
 - 1. Historical figure (like Abraham)
 - 2. Person (he, not it; him, not that)
 - 3. Fallen (murderer, liar)
 - 4. Belief that the devil is a myth
 - a. Gallup poll 70% believe in a "devil"
 - i. 50% of those believe in a personal devil
 - ii. 50% of those believe a symbol of evil



- b. Barna asked born again Christians "the Devil is not a living being, he is just a symbol"
 - i. 32% strongly agree
 - ii. 11% agree somewhat
 - iii. 5% don't know
- B. Everyone Has a Relationship
 - 1. Either the devil is your father or the devil is your enemy
 - 2. The devil gives you the lie you are your own master The Fight, John White
 - 3. We don't struggle against flesh and blood Ephesians 6:12
 - 4. Irreducible minimum
 - a. Born again or not
 - b. Light or darkness
 - c. Saved or lost
 - d. Sons of God or sons of the devil
 - e. For Me or against Me
 - 5. You want the devil as your enemy
 - 6. Greater is he who is in you than he who is in the world 1 John 4:4
- II. The Pretenders
 - A. Their Physical Birthright (v. 39)
 - 1. Abraham's descendents
 - 2. Abraham
 - a. Believed God
 - b. Received heavenly messengers
 - 3. These pretenders
 - a. Don't believe Christ
 - b. Don't receive Christ
 - B. Their Spiritual Boast (v. 41)
 - 1. Related physically, miles apart spiritually
 - a. Manasseh wicked king, son of one of the best kings, Hezekiah 2 Kings 21:11
 - b. We are not born of fornication (alluding to rumor that Jesus was illegitimate)
 - 2. Because we are physical descendants of Abraham, we'll be in heaven
 - a. Rabbis taught that Abraham forbids Israelites from entering hell
 - b. Believe all Jews will be in heaven
 - c. Israel is my firstborn-Exodus 4:22
 - d. Not all who descended from Israel are Israel Romans 9:6-7
 - C. God has no grandchildren
 - 1. Christian parents or grandparents give a great heritage
 - 2. Aaron Burr is the grandson of Jonathan Edwards
 - 3. Every generation must have their own relationship with Christ
- III. The Paternity Test
 - A. Who Do You Love? (v. 42)
 - 1. Love Jesus
 - 2. Talk, spend time with Jesus
 - 3. Though you have not seen him, you love him 1 Peter 1:8
 - 4. Peter, do you love Me? Three times John 21:15-19
 - B. What Do You Understand? (v. 43)
 - 1. Children understand the language of their father
 - 2. Natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit 1 Corinthians 2:14
 - 3. Devil blinds them 2 Corinthians 4:4
 - 4. Hearts must be opened by the Lord Himself
 - C. What Are You Doing? (v. 44)
 - 1. Actions prove your relationships
 - 2. Have the commands and obeys them Luke 6:46-47
 - 3. Paternity of God is demonstrated by conformity of God's kids
 - 4. Obedience proves relationship, does not produce relationship
 - D. When Do You Listen? (vv. 45-47)
 - 1. Refusal to hear reveals the God is not your Father
 - 2. Didn't listen to prophets Isaiah 30:9
 - 3. Jesus didn't comfort their affliction, he afflicted their comfort
